## Lemon Aid

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It's limoncello season. If you can't get to the Amalfi coast, try keeping a bottle of Italy's favorite lemon concentrate in the refrigerator. A sweet-sour liqueur, it's a cold sipper — or top it with sparkling water or prosecco for a long drink on the deck. I like Limoncé — the best seller in Italy. Clever mixologists will also take a half shot of this and fresh lemon juice and shake them over ice with a jigger of gin (or vodka if you must) for a summer cocktail — garnish with a mint leaf. Limoncé — about \$21 per liter. (Oversized because it's a long summer.)
